Winter Uniform

Blue knit cardigan/jumper (St Mary's logo optional)
Grey trousers/blue skirt or blue pinafore dress (No tracksuit bottoms or leggings)
Plain long-sleeved white shirt/blouse (no polo shirts).
Plain grey/ black socks or tights
Tie (compulsory from Year 3, optional Rec-Year 2) - blue with yellow stripes
Sensible shoes in black (no heels, boots or trainers)

Summer Uniform

As winter uniform, plus:
Grey Shorts/Culottes
Short-sleeved white shirt
School style yellow check/gingham dresses
Sensible Sandals with an ankle strap in black (o flip flops, sliders or trainers)
Any sensible cap or sun hat may be worn

PE kits

White t-shirt (St Mary's logo optional)
Blue tracksuit bottoms
Blue sweatshirt (St Mary's logo optional)
Black plimsolls
Black trainers for outdoor PE
In warm weather, blue shorts

Other items

St Mary's Book Bag
St Mary's backpack
Water bottle

For health and safety reasons:
