Class teachers will award golden tickets to children who show exemplary behaviour at all times. When a child is awarded a golden ticket, they have the opportunity to write their name in the class 'Golden Book'.

This Friday, we awarded certificates to children who have remained 'green' throughout the half-term. This is no mean feat, and is a huge cause for celebration! Certificates are awarded for those children who have earned 10+, 25+ or 50+ golds.
