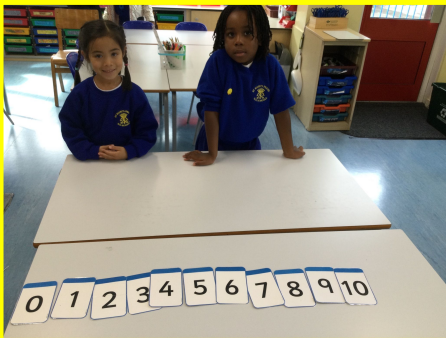
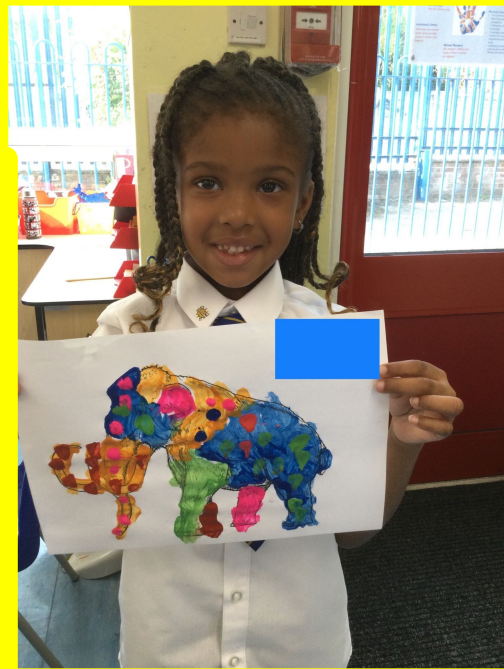

Year 1 is full of talented artists!



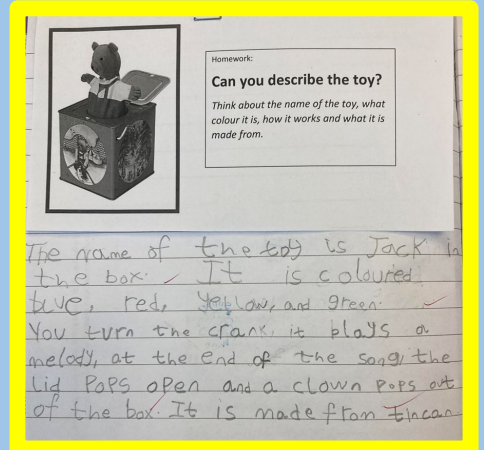

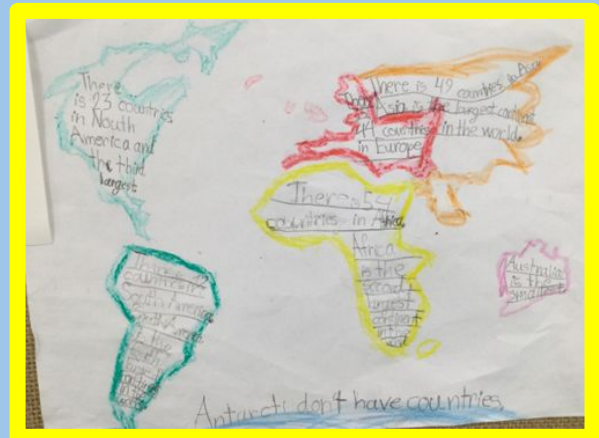

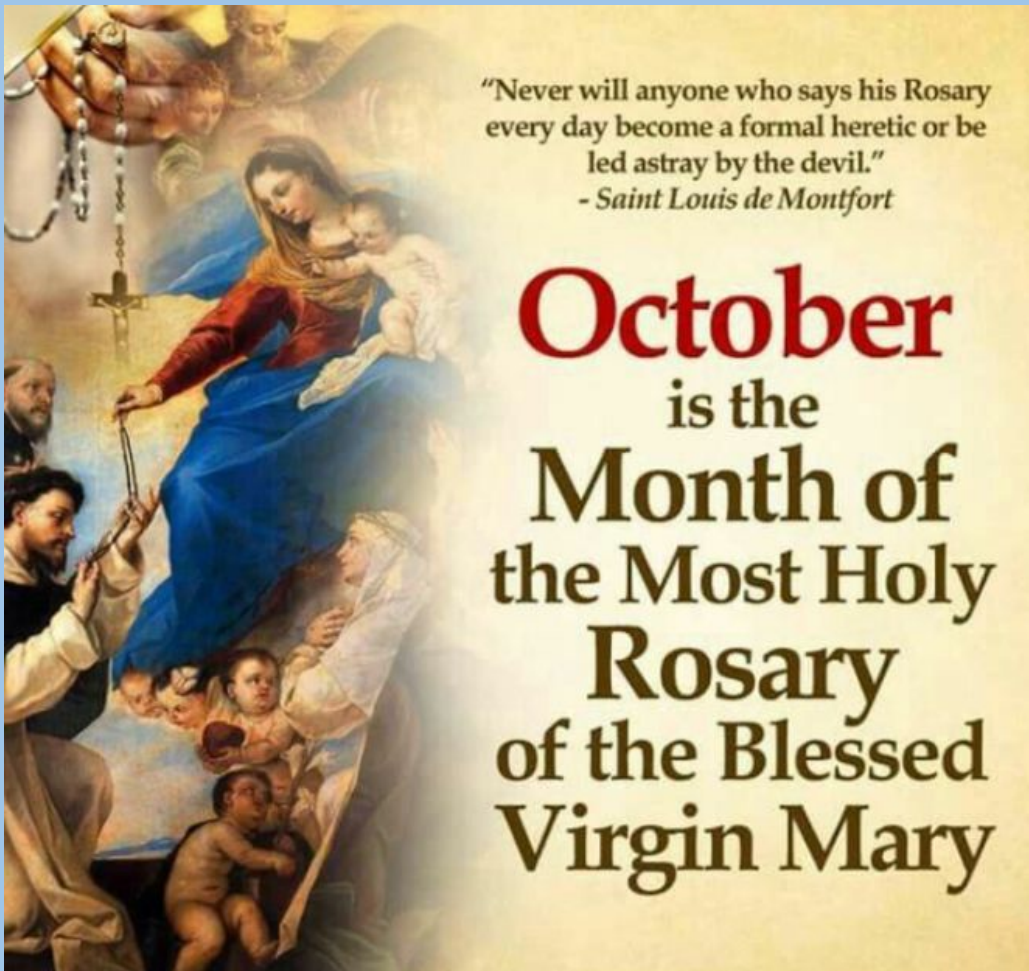
