Protecting Yourself and Others from Scams Online," and discussed how to recognise and avoid online scams. Mrs. Reynolds explained common tricks scammers use, such as fake prizes, misleading links, and messages asking for personal information. She encouraged the children to think critically, question suspicious offers, and always check with a trusted adult before clicking on anything that seems too good to be true. The assembly was followed up this week by a lesson taught by their class teachers.
